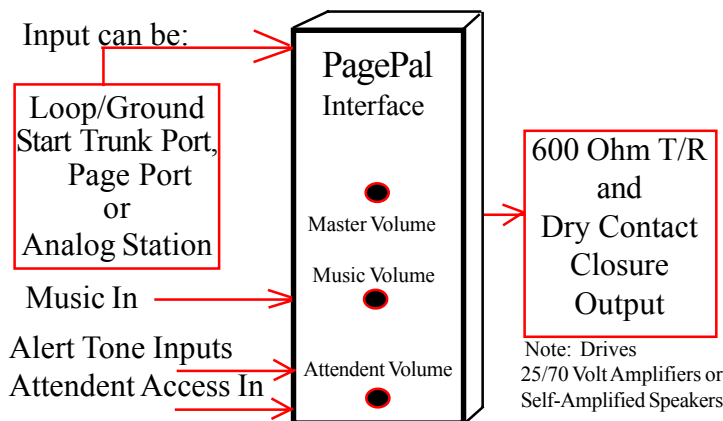

PagePal[®]



The PagePal provides an interface between the telephone system and the paging system. The built-in alert signals permit night ring, chime, or siren to be generated over any paging system. The Attendant Access input complies with OSHA regulations when paging override is needed. The unit accepts a music input and contains three volume controls for easy system adjustments.



The Analog Station input can be connected to a PBX station, C.O. or a Centrex Line. The PagePal will sense ring voltage, trip the ring, and connect the telephone to the paging speakers. The system also works with a CO Port or Paging Port and has the option to time out or release when no voice is present. The feature-rich PagePal easily interfaces with all telephone systems.
